Rimrock Rover Ramble 2006 – A Howling Success!

Roundup, MT, 15 May 2006 – It was a sea of fur and tennis shoes at the 4th annual Rimrock Rover Ramble which took place on May 6th at the Roundup Fairgrounds. A record setting 48 participants took part in either a 1.5 mile leisurely walk or a 3 mile plotted course along the beautiful Musselshell River all to benefit the Rimrock Humane Society. Many came from Roundup, Billings, Columbus, Shepherd and there were also folks from Seattle, Massachusetts and Las Vegas all to walk for this wonderful cause!

"We decided to change the event from September to May hoping we might get a few more participants," stated Rimrock's President Sandy Church. "We were not disappointed – we had 48 people turn out which is the largest number we have ever had!"

Between registrations fees, pledges and sponsorships from local businesses, the Ramble netted approx. \$3,700. "The support from the Roundup community was as awesome as always. We had 15 more sponsors this year than last, wonderful door prizes and many people who couldn't attend still sent pledges anyway. It truly means the world to us" Church said. Rita Carrow from Seattle, WA not only drove many miles to walk in the event but also brought along \$540 in pledges from friends and family!

This event promoted not only good health for owners and pets; it also raised the awareness of the homeless pets in Musselshell County and the beauty of our area.
